Census is the 15th day of instruction. This day determines your financial aid eligibility. If not enrolled full time by census you may be required to repay a portion of your financial aid. Fall 2026 census day is September 18th.

Thinking about withdrawing?

Withdrawing from all or some of your classes may affect your financial aid. Depending on when you withdraw, your aid may need to be reduced or cancelled, which could result in a balance. Withdrawing can also affect your Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) and your eligibility for financial aid in future terms, including the loss of certain legacy provisions that may currently apply to you. Academic Activity Reminder



Students must have academic activity confirmed for every course each term to maintain financial aid eligibility. Faculty play an important role in this process by confirming students' academic activity through CatCourses. Students can monitor the Academic Activity requirement on their Checklist, which will update as activity is confirmed for each course. Academic activity should be confirmed for all courses by the add/drop deadline each term.
