CONSIDERING A WITHDRAWAL?

Withdrawing from the semester may impact your financial aid. Federal rules require a review of aid eligibility, which can result in funds being returned based on the timing of your withdrawal. We encourage students to check with our office before making enrollment changes.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITY MATTERS FOR FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBILITY

Our office actively monitors academic engagement, and financial aid may be adjusted if we are unable to confirm that a student started attendance. Faculty play a critical role in this process by submitting accurate academic activity indicators, and students should ensure they are actively participating early in the term. Early engagement helps protect financial aid eligibility and prevents avoidable adjustments.

- Be a UCM continuing student for 26-27
- Complete your FAFSA/CADAA Application by 3/2
- Have a 3.0+ Cumulative GPA as of Fall 2025

Application is open to all but 3.0+ GPA gets priority
